With a population of just over 6,000 people and an elevation of 7,431' it is a great location to ski either Vail Mountain or Beaver Creek Mountain. Avon boasts restaurants from fine dining to fast food take out as well as numerous walking paths, large grocery store, boutique shops, and community park with a lake.
- Avon provides free bus transportation within Avon, to Beaver Creek Village, and to Vail Village for \$4 each way, with a bus stop located in front of the Christie Lodge.

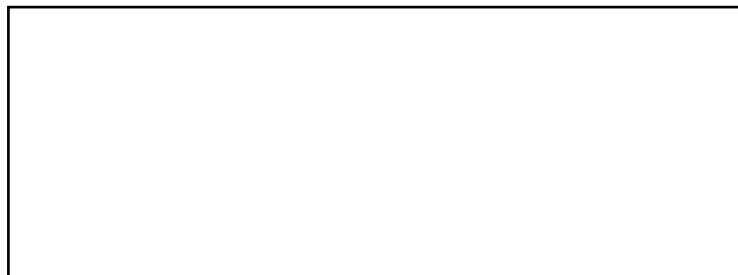
